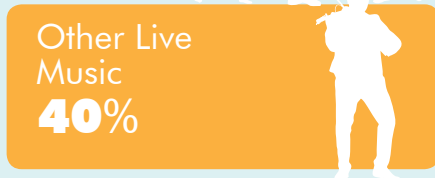


Children's Engagement with the Arts 2017

More than 8 in 10 children and young people attended an arts event at least once a year or more
(86.5%)



Most popular artforms attended



76.4% of children and young people attended an art event in their own time (not organised through school)



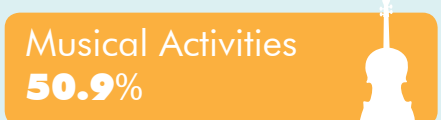
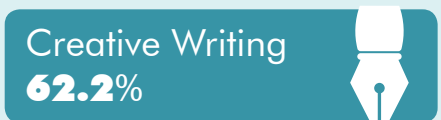
